Thanks to the highway network, Rimini is well connected with the rest of Italy and Europe. It is located on the A14 Milan–Bari Highway and is served by two exits: Rimini Nord and Rimini Sud. From Rimini via the A14, you can easily reach the A4 toward Venice and the A22 toward the Brenner Pass, as well as the A1 toward Florence, Rome, and Naples.
